## **SMF RISKFIRE (Incidents Relating To Fires)**



- 1. Always call the LFB.
- 2. Give the following advice to officers:
  - a. Give HAZMAT information if practicable but avoid unnecessary risk.
  - b. Beware of exploding material.
  - c. Beware of collapsing structures and falling material.
  - d. Check the safety and any RVP.
- 3. If officers must enter the building give the following advice:
  - a. Give a reason for entering (Which must be recorded in remarks).
  - b. Stay in constant contact with the control room.
- c. Officer(s) must work below the smoke layer so crawl close to the floor, try to lay a line to give an escape route, close

doors behind you but remember you need to get out, use the back of your hand to test doors and handles.

Transmit all relevant information to officer(s) attending & record in remarks. For example: "1 - Called. 2a-2d - 127xx & 398xx informed. 3a-3c - Do not apply.".
