Was at base station G34 Chelsea, When fire call was received.

Was riding G346 for the Watch

Approached from the South

Our appliance was situated at Sinder Rd W11, did not move it.

On arrival the whole it looked like the whole tower was alight on side i was facing. From 4<sup>th</sup> to top.

Fire situation was as above.

around 1:45pm

On arrival, was told to get EDBA on and report to leader 1, then was told to collect some hose but report back.

Was asked to help casualty's down, then returned with EDBA set and was tasked to search on 21<sup>st</sup> floor, taking up breaking in gear, reached 18<sup>th</sup> floor when came across a woman and child casualty, the woman as had her leg wedged into the railings of the stairs

and was impossible to move, we retrained the child and made our way at, telling a passing crew about the lady above on way up from 4<sup>th</sup> floor up the middle staircase was completely smoke logged and visibility was zero.

I was counted again and the visibility had cleared until the 9<sup>th</sup> floor, was counted to carry out J&K on the 9<sup>th</sup> floor, managed to reach 2 flats until was stopped by heat and fire.

A Made our way down stairs and debriefed CEC of our progress.

Fire spreaded was farber than I have ever witnessed before.

Only contact with public was keralties removed.

We left incident at 10.00am

I feel we could have done no more, was pushed to actual physical limit.
