I work within the Kelvedon Park Building of the Essex Fire and Rescue Service and I am the Fire Control Officer for that organisation.

Part of this responsibility involves the identification and copying of audio extracts from the recording system which records all 999 telephone calls into the Control Room of the Essex Fire and Rescue Service.

The device used for this purpose initially records the audio data onto a computer system called Divos Voice Recorder

At 15:30 hrs on 17th June 2017 I was on duty at the Kelvedon Park Building when I operated computer equipment and retrieved audio information from the system covering the period of 01:40 to 02:50.

This audio extract was regarding 999 calls from members of the public involving an Essex Fire and Rescue Service operator. This related to an incident with our reference of 56385.

The sections I retrieved, according to our records, commenced at 01:42 hrs on 14/06/17.

At 16:30 hrs I recorded the relevant data onto a blank 'write once' CD-R disc with the reference number of AT (exhibit MT/01).

I later placed this disc (MT) in a secure safe waiting collection by staff from MET Police.

I have no reason to believe that the information retrieved was in any way inaccurate. The equipment used appeared to be working correctly at all times.
