I am a qualified Tactical Flight Officer stationed at the National Police Air Service, Boreham Airfield, Chelmsford, Essex. On Wednesday 14th JUNE 2017, I was on duty in company with PC 521 SPENCER and pilot Captain David CRISAL in the Boreham based helicopter, call-sign NPAS13. At the start of the flight I was using a clean USB drive to record AIMS video back up and snapshots.

About 02:55 on this date we attended the location of the Grenfell Tower, in the London Borough of Kensington and Chelsea. NPAS storm log 33. There we took over from NPAS44 who were in attendance with a widespread fire with in the tower block. On arrival we recorded video footage and took snapshots using the aircraft's on-board video system. This footage shows the fire of the tower and images of occupants at their flat windows trapped by the fire. Through the duration of the flight, I liaised with GT via our Radio, London Fire Brigade via our Radio, and NPAS London Control at Lippitts Hill on my Radio. I liaised directly with LFB with the locations of all persons that we could see with our camera. At some points, the heat was too high for our thermal camera and it caused the camera to flare out, thus needing a re-calibration. Our flight on scene ended at 04:32 when we were relieved by NPAS64 from NPAS REDHILL.

At 06:12 we arrived back on scene at Grenfell Tower and relived NPAS64. NPAS Storm log 49. There we were made aware of a male leaning out of a window on the south aspect of the tower. On arrival we again recorded video footage and took snapshots using the aircraft's onboard video system. This footage shows the fire of the tower and male leaning out of the window in day light. Our flight on scene this time ended at 07:35 when we were relieved by NPAS16 from NPAS BENSON.
