Re: Grenfell Tower Inquiry – Request for Attorney General's undertaking

Thank you for your letter of 20 February 2020. Please may I ask for your assistance with this:

1. Is it proposed that the Inquiry confirm, before a witness commences their evidence, the capacity in which they will give evidence i.e. whether their relationship with a company was and remains so close that their answers are to be attributed to the company and as such give evidence in both a personal capacity and as a representative of the company? (Or other enquiry to establish the nature of their evidence?)
2. If so, is it proposed that the Inquiry would then rule on such a claim?
3. If so, on what basis (applying what legal test?) would this be done?
