

Grenfell Tower Inquiry

RESTRICTION ORDER

UPON READING the application made by the Metropolitan Police Service (“MPS”) on 31 October 2018 (“the application”);

AND UPON HEARING Counsel to the MPS acting as agent for the Crown Prosecution Service (“the CPS”) for the purpose of the application;

AND UPON HEARING Counsel to the Inquiry and Counsel for certain of the Bereaved, Survivors and Residents Core Participants in the Inquiry;

AND HAVING CONSIDERED section 18 and section 19(1) and 19(3) of the Inquiries Act 2005,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, UNTIL FURTHER ORDER

1. no report shall be published of any of the proceedings relating to the application, insofar as the same were or may be held in private ;
2. there shall be no disclosure or publication to any person of the application or any further application that may be made by the CPS pursuant to the directions made on 31 October 2018, save to the persons listed in the attached annex;
3. there shall be no disclosure or publication to any person of any documents produced by the MPS or CPS in support of any such applications save to the persons listed in the attached annex;
4. any person affected by this order may apply for it to be varied or discharged on giving 24 hours’ notice to the Solicitor to the Inquiry.

This order binds all members of the public including Core Participants, their legal teams and the media.
