Documents

- 267,000 documents received by the Inquiry to date.
- Each document is reviewed to assess its relevance.
- Relevant documents are disclosed to core participants.

Witnesses

- Inquiry receives witness statements from core participants, organisations and individuals.
- Witness statements are disclosed to core participants.
- Arrangements made to support vulnerable witnesses.

Experts

- Experts instructed by the Inquiry submit reports for the first phase of Inquiry.
- Expert reports are disclosed to core participants.
- Core participants consider if they will make an application to submit expert advice.

Procedural hearings to discuss how the Inquiry will be run

The programme and sequencing for evidential hearings is determined

The Inquiry issues the papers for the hearings to core participants. Their legal representatives then make written submissions on the issues to be considered.
